You contact the school office to notify the school that your child is absent due to a positive lateral flow test.

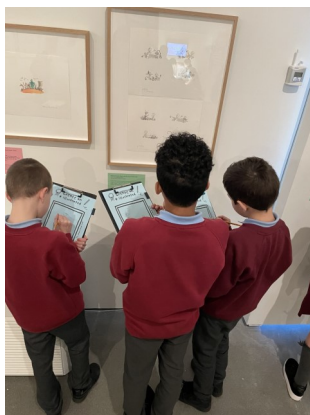
During this phone call, we ask that you inform the staff member if your child is well enough to complete online learning so that their teacher can upload any if needed.
