GANGs Programme

The year 6 pupils have taken part in a week long workshop called GANGs.

GANGs is delivered by specialist staff who has experience within the police force and prisons. GANGs is an early intervention programme aimed at challenging and changing young people's attitude around gang culture. The programme is broken down into 5 different sessions and focuses on issues such as gang identity, county lines, joint enterprise and the importance of speaking to the police.
