## Easter Coffee and Craft sessions.

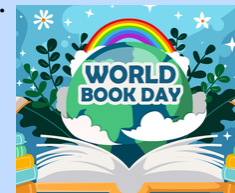
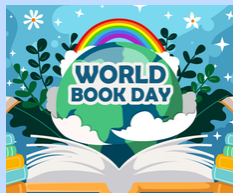
