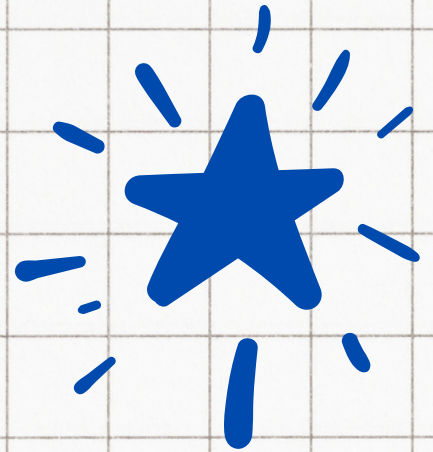

Welcome Back!

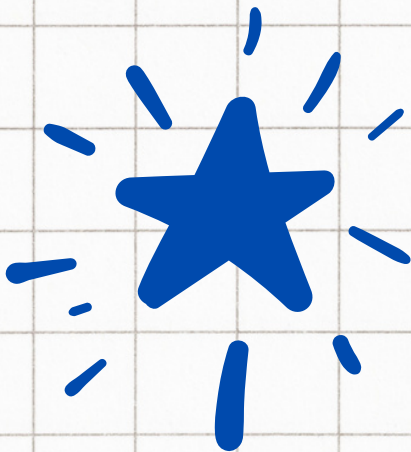
It has been lovely to return to school and see everyone again! We are looking forward to a fantastic year ahead!
